

Investigation ends after “nothing of interest” found at BC3 site

(Butler, PA) State police at Butler and Butler County Community College campus police concluded a two-day investigation Tuesday afternoon after “nothing of interest” was found near a site where private cadaver dogs reportedly alerted handlers when approaching a mound of construction debris on Saturday evening, according to Scott Richardson, BC3’s director of campus police and security.

“The investigation is complete,” Richardson said.

Troopers on Tuesday employed the use of a cadaver dog from the Butler County Search and Rescue Team to search the area that attracted the interest of the private canines on Saturday, Richardson said. The Search and Rescue team cadaver dog also alerted handlers to the same site, which was processed by troopers and BC3 campus police, Richardson said.

“Nothing of interest was found,” Richardson said.

State police and BC3 campus police worked jointly on the investigation, Richardson said.
