Distinguished BC3 Alumni Award Criteria

The BC3 Alumni Association invites nominations for the annual BC3 Distinguished Alumni awards. These awards will recognize former BC3 students who have made outstanding contributions in their chosen profession and demonstrate a commitment to community service. Alumni will be selected for recognition according to the following criteria.

To be eligible for this award, the nominee:

- May be self-nominated or nominated by another person
- Shall have completed a recommended minimum of 24 credits at BC3, with final selection at the discretion of the Alumni Council Selection Committee
- Must not be active on any BC3 leadership board or council - Nominee may be an employee or faculty member of the college
- Shall possess the highest standards of integrity and character to positively reflect and enhance the image of Butler County Community College
- Shall have achieved success in his/her chosen profession
- Should provide evidence of volunteer service/community involvement
- Shall provide inspiration to BC3 students and the community
- Should be able to attend to the ceremony
