Subject: COVID Notification

Dear BC3 Students,

Butler County Community College officials were notified Wednesday evening by a BC3 @ Cranberry student that the student has tested positive for COVID-19. The student, who was last at BC3 @ Cranberry on Aug. 24, has been directed to self-quarantine.

BC3 on Thursday morning notified the Pennsylvania Department of Health, as per protocol established by the [BC3 Health and Safety Plan for Fall 2020](#) for a confirmed case. Contact tracing processes have started and will remain confidential. Anyone identified as having been in close contact with the student will be notified and referred to be tested. College or state Department of Health officials will contact the students' classmates.

Until further notice, temperature checks will be mandatory for all students, faculty, staff and visitors before they enter BC3 @ Cranberry. Individuals with a temperature recorded at or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will not be permitted to enter the facility and should follow voluntary reporting protocol.

BC3 @ Cranberry and all other BC3 locations are sanitized and disinfected each night.

The entire College community should follow guidance set forth in the BC3 Health and Safety Plan for Fall 2020 to support healthy, safe and inclusive learning environments and to mitigate potential risk. Visit bc3.edu/COVID.
