Dear BC3 Student,

Butler County Community College officials were notified Monday afternoon by a BC3 @ LindenPointe student that the student has tested positive for COVID-19. The student, who was last at BC3 @ LindenPointe on Sept. 2, is in self-quarantine.

BC3 on Monday afternoon notified the Pennsylvania Department of Health, as per protocol established by the [BC3 Health and Safety Plan for Fall 2020](#) for a confirmed case. Contact tracing processes have started and will remain confidential. Anyone identified as having been in close contact with the student will be notified and referred to be tested. College or state Department of Health officials will contact the students' classmates.

BC3 @ LindenPointe and all BC3 locations are sanitized and disinfected each night.
