Dear BC3 Students,

Butler County Community College officials were notified the evening of Wednesday, September 16 by a BC3 Main Campus student that the student has tested positive for COVID-19. The student, who was last on BC3 Main Campus the morning of Wednesday, September 16, has been directed to self-quarantine.

This afternoon, BC3 notified the Pennsylvania Department of Health as per protocol established by the [BC3 Health and Safety Plan for Fall 2020](#) for a confirmed case. Contact tracing processes have started and will remain confidential. Anyone identified as having been in close contact with the student will be notified and referred to be tested. College officials have contacted the students' classmates.

BC3 will continue to follow guidance provided by the PA Department of Health as to any other necessary protocol for this specific case.

BC3 Main Campus and all other BC3 locations are sanitized and disinfected each night.

The entire College community should follow guidance set forth in the BC3 Health and Safety Plan for Fall 2020 to support healthy, safe and inclusive learning environments and to mitigate potential risk. Visit bc3.edu/COVID.
