All Camps are held **Monday through Thursday.**

✓ Tuition & Fees

Half Day Tuition \$86
\$52 Tuition + \$34 Fees = \$86 per week, per child
Available to Grade 1 only.

Full Day Tuition \$172
\$104 Tuition + \$68 Fees = \$172 per week, per child
There is a \$2 one-time registration fee per child.

Before and After Care are available for all in-person camps.

After Care 4 p.m. to 5 p.m. | \$20 per week

✓ Lunch & Snacks

Full day campers should pack a lunch daily and will eat with their camp-mates and instructor.

Morning and afternoon snacks are provided, but students may pack their own snacks as well. Water bottles are encouraged.

Students registered for Before Care should pack breakfast.


