Subject: Message from President Neupauer

Good morning, BC3 colleagues,

I hope this email finds you well and enjoying a healthy summer.

The Board of Trustees held its June meeting yesterday at BC3 @ Lawrence Crossing. During the meeting, Executive Director Opitz shared the college's plan for our next phased-in staffing for college personnel this summer. Brian will share the plan, which will begin July 6 and run through Aug. 23, to the college community later today. It will cover all BC3 locations and apply to all college administration and staff. Instruction, of course, remains in a remote capacity through the end of our summer sessions.

With the assistance of Vice President for Academic Affairs Dr. Richardson, we shared our instructional plan for the fall semester with the Board yesterday. The fall plan takes into consideration various college stakeholders, including: faculty, staff, students, PA Department of Education, PA Department of Health, the Governor, Centers for Disease Control and the PA Commission for Community Colleges.

We presented a broad overview of the fall plan. Dr. Richardson and her academic affairs team will share the specifics with faculty as soon as possible. I firmly believe once we roll out our final fall instructional plan, students and/or their parents will have the information needed to make a decision. Currently, we are down 29 percent in credit enrollment for the fall.
