**Subject:** BC3 Moves Summer Courses to Remote Instruction

Dear Students,

Many of you have asked how BC3 would handle summer courses in light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. For everyone's health and safety, **BC3 will move all credit courses to remote instruction for summer 2020.** We are offering our courses May 11 through August 4 via online and remote instruction. Remote instruction includes video conferencing, email, and Internet-based learning management systems (Blackboard) formats.

I'm sure that some of you wonder if the class(es) you selected can be taught remotely. Nearly all classes will be able to be converted. However, **if a class you have registered for is cancelled, you will be directly contacted by email and offered advising to see if you would like to switch to another course.**

BC3's decision aligns with many of the state's other institutions of higher education for the summer of 2020. The commonwealth's 14 state-owned universities, as well as a number of its 14 community colleges, have already decided to move to remote instruction formats this summer.
