Dear Students,

A Butler County Community College student who attends main campus reported today that they have tested positive for COVID-19.

The student was last on BC3's main campus March 9. The college today alerted students who attended classes with the student, and faculty who taught the courses.

The notifications advised students, faculty and staff to contact a healthcare provider should they experience symptoms of COVID-19, and provided information about a community healthcare center that serves adults who do not have health insurance.

In respecting the privacy rights of its student, faculty and staff, BC3 cannot release further details that may identify the student.
