FREE TUTORING @ BC3

Tutoring services at Butler County Community College are offered at no cost to BC3 students enrolled in credit courses. The mission of the BC3 tutoring program--helping students to become confident, independent learners--is accomplished through the creation of consistent, dynamic learning partnerships between tutors and tutees.

Study skills tips, test-taking strategies, and clarification of material covered in class are provided by a competent, student-centered tutoring staff strongly committed to meeting the unique learning needs of the individual student.

Tutoring is provided in several ways:

- ★ Face-to-face by appointment during the day and on a limited basis during the evening at the main campus and at off campus sites
- ★ Online for a limited menu of specific, **selected** online courses
- ★ Scheduled, walk-in tutoring labs for various courses, if staff is available

(Tutoring is not guaranteed for ALL courses.)

FACE-TO-FACE TUTORING

STAFF

The tutoring staff is comprised of peer, associate, and professional level tutors who have outstanding credentials. Numbered among the staff are academically accomplished BC3 students--including Phi Theta Kappa members, part-time faculty, former teachers, engineers, RNs, accountants, BC3 alumni, and distinguished professionals from the community.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students who wish to apply for tutoring can do so in person at BC3 Main Campus and at any BC3 off-campus center. Or, ***sign up for a tutor on your computer*** at <http://bc3.edu/services/tutoring>. **The student's 7-digit student ID number is required on the application.**

The student must also have an active my.bc3.edu student email to receive the first tutoring appointment notification and to communicate with the assigned tutor.

Eligible for one hour of free tutoring per subject per week, the student is obligated to meet regularly each week with the tutor until the student notifies staff that the service is no longer needed.

One-on-one tutoring is not guaranteed; the student may be placed in a study group.

WALK-IN TUTORING

If staff is available, walk-in tutoring labs **may** be offered at specific times during the semester. Please check with the tutoring staff for additional details.

ONLINE TUTORING

Online tutoring is available on a limited basis to students enrolled in specific, **selected** online courses. Please contact the Coordinators of Tutoring at tutoring@bc3.edu for information about online tutoring and how to apply.

FAQ'S

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE TUTORING?

BC3 students who are currently enrolled in credit courses are eligible.
